It is disheartening to inform you that the bus trip to see “Ragtime” has been cancelled. We did not have enough sign-ups to move forward on the event. We will be returning the money to those who has paid. We are actively researching alternative bus trips.

If you have not paid, we will be collecting the membership due of \$20 for 2024.

- (1) We still have tickets available for “**Trailblazing Women of Country - A Tribute to Patsy, Loretta, and Dolly**” at the McCarter Theatre. The show is on Sunday, April 14th, at 7:00PM. The price is \$26 for members and \$31 for non-members.
- (2) **We no longer have any tickets available for “Nunsense”** at the Kelsey Theatre (West Windsor). **You can sign up to be on the waiting list.** The show is on Saturday, May 4th, at 2:00PM. The price is \$20 for members and \$24 for non-members
- (3) Sign-up and payment continue for the **Birthday Breakfast** at the Star Diner (Hillsborough) on Thursday, April 18th, 10:00AM. Free for those with

- birthdays from January to April. Others pay \$10. Final sign-up and payment are at the April meeting. Choices are from a select menu.
- (4) Sign-up continues for our annual **Picnic** to be held on Thursday, June 20th at noon. Same as in the past few years, it will be held at Montgomery Veterans Park and catered by Elmer's Catering. The picnic is exclusive to members and the cost is \$10. We reluctantly have to increase the price for the picnic. Even with charging \$10, the organization is subsidizing \$12 per attendee just for the base price of the catering, which does not include other expenses such as bottled water, soft drinks and table clothes.
 - (5) Sign-up starts for "**Anything Goes**" at the Music Mountain Theatre (Lambertville, NJ). The show is on Sunday, July 14th, at 3:00PM. Price is \$20 for members and \$25 for non-members. Sign-up closes at the May meeting.
 - (6) Sign-up continues for the bus trip to **Bally's Casino** in Atlantic City. The price is \$42 for members and non-members. A \$2 tip for the bus driver is included. Bally's is offering a \$20 voucher to be used at the casino.
